About Dominica

Dominica is a commonwealth country in the West Indies. The capital, Roseau, is located on the western side of the island. The Dominica citizenship program is a highly reputable Citizenship program that has been in operation since 1993 and is legally guaranteed by the Dominican government to encourage foreign investment, making it possible to obtain Dominican citizenship by investment in only 2-4 months. Dominican citizens enjoy the comfort of traveling to 124+ countries without the need for a visa, including major business hubs in Europe, North- and Latin America as well as Asia, making the Dominican citizenship an extremely attractive choice. Applicants and their dependents are not required to live in Dominica to obtain citizenship, meaning you can apply for and receive your passports without having to relocate the entire family or renounce your original nationality.

As a citizen of Dominica, you gain Visa-free travel to over 124 countries, including the United Kingdom, Singapore, Hong Kong and Ireland. Furthermore, with your Dominican passport, application process for additional foreign visas will be an easier process.

You do not need to denounce your current citizenship, as Dominica allows for dual citizenship.

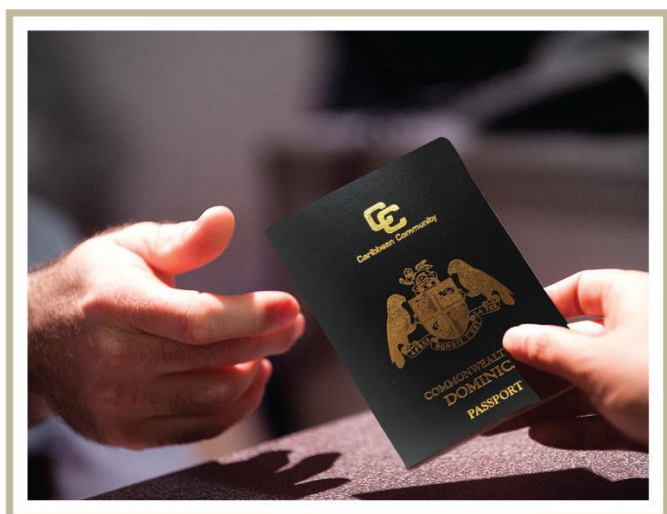
Tax & Business Advantages

Security for your Family

Your spouse, children (below the age of 28) and dependent parents over the age of 55 can apply to obtain their Dominican passports along with the applicant and will be able to enjoy life in one of the happiest places in the world.



Investment Options

There are two different investment options, which serve as a qualifier for your application to the Dominican citizenship program.

Option 1

Contribution to Dominica's **Economic Diversification Fund (EDF)**

- For a single applicant: **US \$100,000** non-refundable
- For main applicant and spouse: **US \$175,000** non-refundable
- For main applicant, spouse and two children: **US \$200,000** non-refundable

Option 2

US\$200,000 (minimum) Investment in pre-approved real estate projects

*Plus government processing fees and due diligence fees

Steps and Procedures

Month 1

Step 1:

Client chooses either investment or donation option. Client signs the **Huriya** contract, and pays initial retainer.

Step 2:

Huriya assists the client to gather all required documentation, and to complete the various Government application forms for submission to the CIU.

Step 3:

Second payment is made, and file is submitted.

Month 2-4

Step 4:

Issuance of **Approval** letter by the CIU (Citizenship-by-Investment Unit), third payment is required immediately.

Step 5:

Naturalization certificate is issued

Month 5

Step 6:

Huriya Private receives client passport(s). Passport can be either picked up from **Huriya Private** office or delivered to clients home address, (locally or internationally).
