## About Grenada

The Grenada Citizenship by Investment Program was launched in 2013 under the regulations of the Grenada Citizenship by Investment Act, making it possible to obtain Grenadian citizenship by investment in only 60 business days. Grenada is one of the very few nations whose citizens do not require a visa to travel to the People's Republic of China.

Furthermore, Grenadian citizens can apply for USA E-2 Visa, which allows them to apply for a Green Card, start a business and live in the United States, making the Grenadian citizenship an extremely attractive choice. Applicants and their dependents are not required to live in Grenada to obtain citizenship, meaning you can apply for and receive secondary passports without having to relocate the entire family or renounce your original nationality.



## Benefits

### Visa Free Travel for UK, Schengen & China

Grenadian citizens can travel without visa restrictions to more than 128 international and Commonwealth countries these includes the UK and Schengen States as well as important business hubs like Singapore and Hong Kong.

Furthermore, Grenada is one of the very few nations whose citizens do not require a visa to travel to the People's Republic of China.

### Tax & Business Advantages

Grenada has no foreign income, wealth, gift, inheritance, or capital gains tax. There is no restriction on the repatriation of profits and imported capital Grenada's currency, the East Caribbean dollar (XCD), is pegged to the

United States dollar (USD). Lastly, there is duty-free trading in the Caribbean.

Another great advantage includes the eligibility for **USA E-2 Visa**. This visa allows Grenadian citizens to apply for a **Green Card**, start a business and live in the United States, with the possibility of obtaining American Citizenship after 5 years.

### Security for your Family

Children up to 30 years and dependent parents over 55 years can apply to obtain citizenship along with you, with the possibility to relocate to any other Caribbean Community (CARICOM).

Future generations of your family will continue to benefit from their Grenadian citizenship and enjoy the dynamic, vibrant, and extremely hospitable local community as well as countless opportunities for relaxation and adventure.



# Investment Options

There are two different investment options, which serve as a qualifier for your application to the Grenadian citizenship program.

## Option 1

Contribution to **National Transformation Fund (NTF)**:

- For a single applicant: **US \$150,000** (non-refundable)
- For a family of up to 4: **US \$200,000** (non-refundable)
- For each additional dependent, a fee of **US \$25,000** (non-refundable) applies.

## Option 2

**US\$220,000** (minimum) Investment in pre-approved real estate projects.

The property can be sold in approximately 3 years.

# Steps and Procedures

## Month 1

Step 1:

Client chooses either investment or donation option. Client signs the Huriya contract, and pays initial retainer.

Step 2:

Huriya assists the client to gather all required documentation, and to complete the various Government application forms for submission to the CIU.

Step 3:

Second payment is made, and file is submitted.

## Month 2-4

Step 4:

Issuance of **Approval** letter by the CIU (Citizenship-by-Investment Unit), third payment is required immediately.

Step 5:

Naturalization certificate is issued

## Month 5

Step 6:

**Huriya Private** receives client passport(s). Passport can be either picked up from **Huriya Private** office or delivered to clients home address, (locally or internationally).
